Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop in the beginning hiring 4 people. Product sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and other components. Through five years of operation, the company had expanded to forty staff and their annual sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is one of the top global manufacturers in the material handling trade.

Manufacture and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. During the past sixty years, the material handling business has matured into a highly advanced field and Cascade has proudly played a part on this progress. Cascade at present continues to develop as the leader supplier of forklift accessories and different related items. The business feels assured in their skill to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, manufacturing and selling hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was done in 1956 on a brand new office to be able to house all the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current headquarters. After 15 years of business, total staff reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the business recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing services within the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are fabricated globally because of a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of 5 firms, along with the worldwide best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
